To Whom It May Concern

PERMIT TO LEGALLY IGNORE THE LOCKDOWN

This is to certify that the holder of this Permit (inclusive of his/her family, business and workers) is a supporter of the Liberty Fighters Network (LFN) and may rely on its protection from all unconstitutional and unlawful acts and policies of the South African Government in relation to the National State of Disaster declared on 15 March 2020 in terms of Section 27(1) of the Disaster Management Act, 2002 (Act No. 57 of 2002) – hereafter referred to as the “DMA”.

LFN and its President, Reyno De Beer, have obtained a Court Order against the Minister of Cooperative Governance and Traditional Affairs in the High Court Gauteng Division Pretoria under case number 21542/2020 on 2 June 2020 to the extent that the DMA Regulations [excluding regulations 36, 38, 39(2)(d) and (e) and 41] had been declared as unconstitutional and invalid and that the enforcement thereof have ceased at midnight on Tuesday, 23 June 2020 and are no longer valid in relation to declarations of invalidity law. This is to certify further that this Permit allows the holder to legally ignore any of the invalid DMA Regulations and are exempted from it.

In the event that the Government, or any law enforcement agent, attempts to enforce or prosecute in relation to the invalid DMA Regulations against the holder (or his family, business or workers), LFN will consider such action as retaliation of the Government against LFN and its supporters and as politically inspired.

Any Permit holder (or his family, or workers) arrested in terms of the mentioned invalid DMA Regulations shall immediately be considered as a political prisoner and LFN will immediately alert the United Nations, African Union, BRICS, SADC, European Union, Amnesty International, the Government of the United States of America, and other international bodies for assistance and to call on our supporters to find refuge in embassies and consulates of any other country for protection and becoming political refugees.
